

Cook and the Pacific' Exhibition – National Library

The Club has again reserved the Viking's Club Community 24-Seater Bus for a visit to National Library's *Cook and the Pacific* Exhibition. Visitors to Cook and the Pacific will follow James Cook's three remarkable Pacific voyages and explore this spectacular region through the eyes of the British voyagers and the First Nations peoples they met.

The exhibition takes visitors on a journey to the Pacific 250 years ago, with destinations including Tahiti, New Zealand, the east coast of Australia, Hawaii and even Siberia.

With content drawn from around the world, visitors will be enthralled by maps, manuscripts, rare books, large oil paintings, delicate watercolours by voyage artists, medallions, cartoons and poetry.
